

## Call for Poster Abstract Submissions for the 2012 Annual Nevada State Climate Change Meeting

## **Abstract Preparation Guidelines**

Abstracts should have 1" margins, and be single-spaced, using Times New Roman, 12-point font with a maximum word count of 300 for the Abstract Body. Please include the following information in the Abstract.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Line: Title of research
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Line: Authors and affiliations (underline presenting author)
- Abstract Body: Please include the goals, general approach used and major findings of the research (300 words maximum)

Please also indicate if presenting author is a graduate or undergraduate student.

Abstracts must be submitted in MS Word format by **Monday**, **January 9**, **2012** to Michele Casella, NSF EPSCoR Education, Outreach & Diversity Administrator, at michele casella@nshe.nevada.edu.

You will be notified by January 20, 2012 as to whether you have been selected to present a poster at the Annual Climate Change meeting.
