## Nevada receives grant for climate change research

RENO, Nev. - Nevada's higher education system has received a \$15 million federal grant to research regional climate change in a tristate project during the next five years.

Researchers from the Desert Research Institute, University of Nevada, Reno, University of Nevada, Las Vegas and Nevada State College will analyze and model the effects of regional climate change on the state's ecosystems and water resources.

Nevada will collaborate with New Mexico and Idaho, which also received grant money to participate in the project that will focus on the Great Basin ecosystem.
