- d) A representative for broadening participation of underrepresented groups, preferably from one of NSHE's Minority Serving Institutions (MSI);
- e) A representative from the Nevada Governor's Office of Economic Development (GOED);
- f) One member from the Nevada Legislature;
- g) A representative from the aerospace/defense sector (private or federal);
- h) A representative from the business information technology (IT) sector;
- i) A representative from the business, entrepreneurship and technology sector; and
- j) The Nevada EPSCoR Director as ex officio member.
